



# Verifying your Identity for Companies House

### Step-by-Step Guide Verifying Your Identity with Companies House

### Why You Need to Verify

- From 18 November 2025, all directors and People with Significant Control (PSCs) must verify their identity with Companies House
- New directors/PSCs must verify before appointment
- Existing ones must do so within the 12 month transition period or when filing their next confirmation statement
- This is to combat fraud and improve transparency

### What You Will Need

Before you start you will need:

- A "GOV.UK One Login"
- A valid photo ID (UK or foreign passport, UK or EU driving licence or biometric residence permit)
- Your personal details (full name, date of birth, address history)
- A smartphone (if you will use the GOV.UK mobile phone app)

### **How to Verify**

### Step 1: Create a GOV.UK One Login

- Go to GOV.UK One Login
   (This account is separate from your Companies House or Government Gateway login)
- Enter email address
- A 6-digit code will be emailed to you, which you will need to enter
- Create a password
- Choose how to get your security codes, opt via text message
- Enter your mobile number
- A 6-digit code will be texted to you, which you will need to enter
- Your account will then be set up

### **Step 2: Start the Verification Service**

- Use the Verify your identity for Companies House service
- Scroll down the page until you come across the green button that says,
   Verify your identity >
- Then you will need to log in to your GOV.UK One Login. This is done by scrolling down and clicking on the green button that says:
   Go to GOV.UK One Login
- Once redirected to the sign in page, please sign in using the account details you created in Step 1
- You will be asked 'Has your identity been verified for Companies House', click 'No' and then

### Step 3: Choose How to Verify

You can pick one of these three options:

- 1. Using the GOV.UK One Login mobile app, this is the quickest and simplest method:
  - o Download the app to your smartphone
  - Scan your passport or driving licence
  - o Take a live selfie for comparison

### 2. Answering Security Questions on a Computer/Tablet

- Available only if you have a UK passport, UK driving licence, or credit history
- o Questions may be about your bank, credit card, or loans

### 3. Verify in Person at the Post Office

- If digital options don't work, you can complete the check in person at selected Post Offices
- Take your ID documents with you

### **Step 4: Get Your Personal Code**

- Once verified, Companies House gives you a personal code
- This proves you have verified your identity
- Save it securely and send it to info@rbp.co.uk immediately

### How to verify your identity using GOV.UK One Login mobile phone app

 Once you have finished following Step 2, scroll down to the bottom of the page and click

## We're taking you to verify your identity with GOV.UK One Login

GOV.UK will ask you some simple questions to find the best way for you to verify your identity. Depending on the answers you provide, you'll then be guided to use one of the following routes:

### Route 1: Use the GOV.UK mobile phone app

This is the fastest way to verify. GOV.UK One Login allows you to download an app that scans your biometric ID.

The mobile app:

- · is fast and simple
- works with any up-to-date mobile phone
- is secure the app only communicates data, it doesn't store anything

You can delete the app when you've finished.

Check if your mobile phone can use the GOV.UK app (opens in new tab)

### Route 2: Verify online without the mobile phone app

If you cannot verify using the mobile phone app, you can still verify online without it. You'll need to answer a few questions about yourself to confirm who you are.

#### Route 3: Verify in person

If you cannot verify using the mobile phone app or online, GOV.UK One Login will tell you how to verify in person at the Post Office.



- You will then be asked 'Are you on a computer or tablet right now?'
  - o If on a computer or tablet; click 'Yes I am on a computer or tablet'
  - Click on if you have access to an iPhone or Android
  - Scan the QR code and you will be redirected and prompted to download the GOV.UK One Login mobile app
  - o You will then need to sign in and continue the rest of the steps on the app
  - Once followed the steps on the mobile app using your smartphone, you will be redirected back to your computer or tablet and will be giving the option to finish proving your identity by clicking
     Continue

- You will then need to confirm your details by clicking I confirm my details are correct
- It will then need to check your details. To allow it to do this, click


